# Grantlea Downs School Out of Zone Enrolments Term 3 & 4 2023

The Board invites applications from parents who wish to enrol their child at Grantlea Downs for Term 3 & 4 2023.

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office.

Applications for out-of-zone places are now being invited for those students who will become eligible for enrolment during the period 17 July to 15 December 2023.
