GRANTLEA DOWNS SCHOOL OUT OF ZONE ENROLMENTS TERM 3 & 4 2024

The Board invites applications from parents who wish to enrol their child at Grantlea Downs for Term 3 & 4 2024.

Enrolment at the school is governed by an enrolment scheme, details of which are available from the school office.

Applications for out-of-zone places are now being invited for those students who will become eligible for enrolment during the period 22 July to 17 December 2024. We currently have places available in Year 0, Year 1, Year 2, Year 3, Year 5, Year 6 and Year 7. The exact number of places will depend on the number of applications received from students who live within the school zone.

The deadline for receipt of applications for out-of-zone places is **Tuesday 7 May 2024**.

If a ballot for out-of-zone places is required, it will be held on 14 May 2024. Parents will be informed of the outcome of the ballot within three school days of the ballot being held.

ADVANCED NOTICE OF CHANGES TO THE METRO SCHOOL BUS SERVICE - T3 Route

There will be upcoming changes to concessions, following **central government's changes** to its Community Connect Concessions Scheme.

In Timaru, the free fares for 5–12-year-olds on Metro School and Temuka services, and the MyWay by Metro concession for 19–24-year-olds, will cease on 30 April. This means children travelling on the Metro School Services will need to start paying the 95-cents per ride fare again.

Children aged 5-12-years-old who use Metro services will need to start topping-up their Metro cards again to enable them to pay the child fares.

MyWay's \$1.50 child fare will remain.
