ShakeOut

This month we are taking part in New Zealand ShakeOut, our national earthquake drill and tsunami hikoi, at 9.30 on 18 October. We will be practising our Drop, Cover and Hold drill then walking our tsunami evacuation route (weather permitting). We will be crossing onto the other side of Grants Road and walking until we turn left onto Old North Road. We will continue walking uphill, veering left onto Selwyn Street and meeting at Marchwiel Park. This is our meeting place. In the event of a real Civil Defence emergency where there has been a Tsunami Evacuation notice given and sirens sounded, this is where you can expect to find us and collect your child/children. In the event of a real emergency and threat of Tsunami a sign will be on the gate stating we are at Marchwiel Park, otherwise we will remain on the school site.

We are also taking part in the New Zealand ShakeOut Schools Challenge, organised by the Ministry of Civil Defence & Emergency Management and the Earthquake Commission. Your child/children will be bringing home a Challenge booklet to work through as a family. There are prizes for everyone that completes the 8 challenges and returns their signed checklist to Mrs Gordon in Room 8, before the end of October.

Information about the "Standards Events"

The "Standards Athletics Sports" that your child will be competing in is designed to have each child compete against prearranged standards, but it also accommodates those who excel and are more competitive. In standards events students are competing to a standard rather than just against other students. Each child will score 1, 2 or 3 for every event. All those achieving a 3 will then compete for a 1st, 2nd or 3rd placing.

The athletics sports is also an Interhouse sports competition with a shield up for grabs. The winning house will be decided by all the students' individual points being added together. The students are encouraged to dress in the colour of their house as this promotes house spirit and competition.
